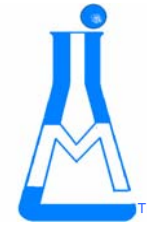

Research is StewardshipSM

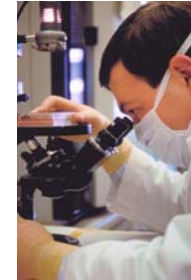
Researchers are responsible for the stewardship of their laboratory funding, facilities, and personnel. Mismanagement can result in stoppage of funded research, significant penalties, risk to the health and lives of subjects and personnel, environmental contamination, invalid research results, and loss of personnel and reputation.

Researchers have devoted years of study in their scientific disciplines, but have received little or no laboratory management training.

As a result, research inefficiencies, litigation, and other losses because of regulatory non-compliance have resulted in annual penalties and lost opportunity costs of more than \$100 million nationally. More than 20 national laboratories have had to suspend operations in recent years because of mismanagement.
